



# **RAFFLES INTERNATIONAL PET RELOCATION CHECK LIST ("RIPRCL")**

- Obtain the pet relocation quote from reputable pet movers
- Select your pet mover. Do not select your pet mover only based on the price
- Arrange vaccinations, travel documents and other important matters well in advance
- Provide the accurate particulars of the pet/s such as breed, sex, age, colour and name
- Check if your pet has an AVA license
- Check if your pet has been sterilized (for dog only)
- Check your pet has an ISO microchip
- Check your pet has a valid annual vaccination
- Check your pet has a valid Rabies vaccination
- Check your pet has a valid Bordetella vaccination
- Check your pet has an airline approved travelling cage
- Check for all details and formalities of the destination country
- Give your pet's measurement to the pet mover if you do not have a travelling cage
- Include a blanket, toy or something your pet is familiar with in the travel crate with your pet
- Do not sedate your pet unless specifically recommended by a vet. Pets sedated and travelling at the flying altitude can be susceptible to de-hydration, disorientation and travel sickness



- Do not feed your pet a full meal eight hours prior to the flight as this may cause an upset stomach
- Take your pet for a walk or let your pet stretch its legs before they go into the travel crate
- Confirm how you want your pet to travel together with you on the same flight, as excess baggage or alone as cargo
- Decide your pet's arrival date if not flying with you
- You have done all the preparations. Sit back and welcome your pet at your new destination
